How to help SE Asian homeowners facing foreclosure

As the foreclosure crisis sweeps across the state, organizations that encounter distressed homeowners are getting more and more questions about mortgage foreclosure. To help provide answers to these questions, the SE Asian Foreclosure Prevention Task Force and the Minnesota Home Ownership Center are offering a free training workshop on helping struggling homeowners and the assistance that is available in Minnesota.

This training will provide an overview of the foreclosure process, where to refer homeowners, an overview of assistance programs and information on how to prepare homeowners, especially homeowners in SE Asian Communities, to talk with a housing counselor or loan servicer.

Who Should Attend?

This training is specifically designed for staff from public, private, governmental and non-profit organizations who work with SE Asian homeowners who may be struggling with their monthly mortgage payment. 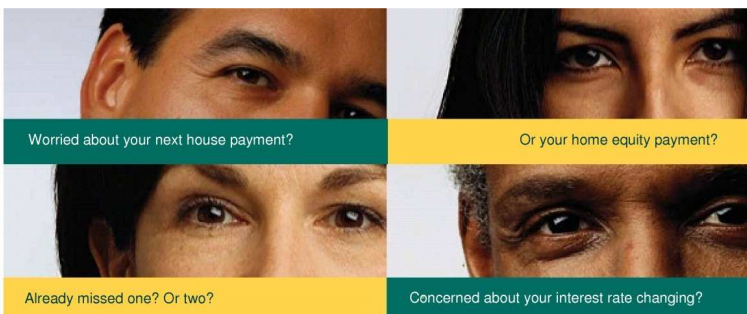
